POINT #1:**

**DEFEND**

"Now after five days  
Ananias the high priest  
came down with the  
elders and a certain  
orator named Tertullus.

They gave  
evidence...against Paul."

***Acts 24:1***

"Then Paul, after the  
governor had nodded  
to him to speak,  
answered...I do the  
more cheerfully answer  
for myself,"

***Acts 24:10***

**SERMONIC  
POINT #2:  
DISCERN**

“And they neither  
found me in the temple  
disputing...nor inciting  
the crowd, either in the  
synagogues or in the  
city.”  
*Acts 24:12*

“Nor can they prove  
the things of which  
they now accuse me.”

*Acts 24:13*

“But this I  
confess...according to the  
Way which they call a  
sect, so I worship the  
GOD of my fathers,  
believing all things which  
are written...” *Acts 24:14*

**SERMONIC  
POINT #3:  
DECIDE**

“I have hope in GOD,  
which they themselves  
also accept that there  
will be a resurrection of  
the dead both of the  
just and the unjust.”  
*Acts 24:15*

“unless it is for this one statement which I cried out... ‘Concerning the resurrection of the dead, I am being judged by you...’ ”  
*Acts 24:21*

“Now as he reasoned about righteousness, self-control, and the judgment to come,  
“Felix was afraid and answered, ‘Go away...’”  
*Acts 24:25*

**SERMONIC  
POINT #4:  
DEPEND**

“Meanwhile he (Felix) also hoped that money would be given him by Paul, that he might release him.”  
*Acts 24:26*

“But after two years Porcius Festus succeeded Felix; and Felix, wanting to do the Jews a favor, left Paul bound.”  
*Acts 24:27*
