"It Just Doesn't Make Sense"

SERMON POINTS: 1. FACTIONS 2. FOOLISHNESS 3. FULCRUM

SERMONIC POINT #1: FACTIONS

"Now I *plead* with you...that you all speak the same thing, and *that* there be *no divisions* among you,..."

I Corinthians 1:10a

"...but *that* you be perfectly *joined together* in the same mind and in the same judgment."

I Corinthians 1:10b

"Now I say this, that each of you says, "I am of *Paul*," or "I am of *Apollos*," or "I am of *Cephas*," or "I am of *Christ*."

I Corinthians 1:12

"Is Christ divided?
Was Paul crucified

Vas Paul crucified for you?

Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?"

I Corinthians 1:13

"I thank God that I baptized *none of you* except Crispus and Gaius, lest anyone should say that I had baptized in my own name."

I Corinthns.1:14-15

"For Christ did not send me to baptize, *but to preach* the gospel, not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of no effect."

I Corinthns.1:17

SERMONIC POINT #2: FOOLISHNESS

"For the message of the cross is *foolishness* to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the *power of God."* I Corinthns.1:18

"For it is written:

'I will destroy the
wisdom of the wise, And
bring to nothing the
understanding of the
prudent.' " Ish.29:14

I Corinthns.1:19

"Where is the wise?
Where is the scribe?
Where is the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?"

I Corinthns.1:20

"For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God,..."

I Corinthns.1:21a

"...it pleased God through the *foolishness* of the message preached to save those who believe."

I Corinthns.1:21b

"For Jews request a sign...Greeks seek after wisdom; but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness,"

I Corinthns.1:22-23

"but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God."

I Corinthns.1:24

"Because the **foolishness** of God is wiser than men, and the **weakness** of God is stronger than men."

I Corinthns.1:25

"For you see your calling, brethren, that not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called."

I Corinthns.1:26

foolish things...to put to shame the wise, and...the weak things...to put to shame the things which are mighty;"

I Corinthns.1:27

things...and the things which are despised...and the things which are not, to bring to nothing the things that are,"

I Corinthns.1:28

SERMONIC POINT #3: FULCRUM

"that no flesh should glory in His presence."

"But of Him you are in Christ Jesus," I Corinthn.1:29-30a

"...who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption—"

I Corinthns.1:30b

"that, as it is written,

'He who glories, let him
glory in the Lord."

I Corinthns.1:31

Jeremiah 9:24
