**SERMONIC**  
**POINT #1:**  
**LEADERSHIP**

“For when we were  
still without strength,  
in due time  
CHRIST died  
for the ungodly.”

**Romans 5:6**

“For scarcely for a  
righteous man will one  
*die*, yet perhaps for a  
good man someone  
would even dare to *die*.”

**Romans 5:7**

**SERMONIC**  
**POINT #2:**  
**LOVE**

“But God demonstrates  
His own *love* toward us,  
in that while  
we were still sinners,  
Christ died for us.”

**Romans 5:8**

“Much more then,  
having now been  
*justified by His blood*,  
we shall be saved from  
wrath through Him.”

**Romans 5:9**

**SERMONIC**  
**POINT #3:**  
**LIFE**

“For if when we were enemies we were *reconciled to God* through the death of His Son...”

**Romans 5:10a**

“...much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved *by His life.*”

**Romans 5:10b**

“And not only *that*, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the *reconciliation.*”

**Romans 5:11**

“But the *free gift* is not like the offense. For if by the one man’s offense many *died...*”

**Romans 5:15a**

“...much more the grace of God and *the gift by the grace* of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.”

**Romans 5:15b**

“For if by the one man’s offense *death* reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace...”

**Romans 5:17a**

“...and of the gift of righteousness will reign in *life* through the One, Jesus Christ.)”
