FOR "GLORY:"**  
*Doxa - Δόξα*  
*"Brilliant Light"*

A **doxology** (Ancient Greek: δοξολογία *doxologia*, from δόξα, *doxa*, "glory" and -λογία, *-logia*, "saying")<sup>[1][2][3]</sup> is a short **hymn** of praises to **God** in various forms of **Christian** worship, often added to the end of **canticles**, **psalms**, and hymns. The tradition derives from a similar practice in the **Jewish synagogue**,<sup>[4]</sup> where some version of the **Kaddish** serves to terminate each section of the service.
