# <u>SERMONIC</u> <u>PNT. #1:</u>

Who was Miriam?

"The name of Amram's wife was **Jochebed**, the daughter of Levi, who was born to Levi in Egypt; and she bore to Amram: Aaron and Moses and their sister **Miriam**."

Numbers 26:59

"3But when *she* could hide him no longer, *she* got him a wicker basket and covered it over with tar and pitch. Then *she* put the child into it and set it among the reeds by the bank of the Nile...'" Exodus 2:3 "4*His sister* stood at a distance to find out what would happen to him. 5The daughter of Pharaoh came down to bathe at the Nile, with her maidens...; and she saw the basket...and sent her maid, and she brought it to her....'" **Exodus 2:4-5**

## <u>PNT. #4:</u>

Why was Miriam Bitter?

#### Meaning of Name:

"Mar" means 'bitter!'

'Mar-ah' - bitter waters;

'Mar-y' - 'bitter'

'Mir-iam' - bitter

"4*His sister* stood at a distance to find out what would happen to him. 5The daughter of Pharaoh came down to bathe at the Nile, with her maidens...; and she saw the basket...and sent her maid, and she brought it to her....'" **Exodus 2:4-5**
