“Sons were also born to **Shem**, whose older brother was Japheth; Shem was the ancestor of all the sons of Eber.

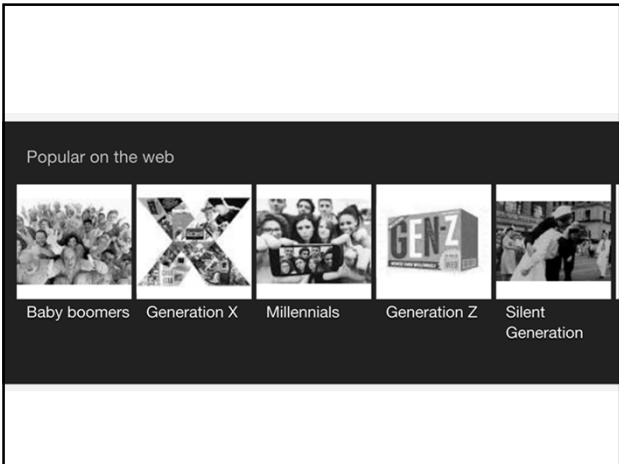
The region where they lived stretched from Mesha toward Sephar, in the eastern hill country.
