SERMON POINT #1: WORSHIP GOD...

...IN MORNING

"My voice YOU shall hear *in the morning*, O LORD;In the morning I will direct *it* to YOU,And I will look up." **Psalm 5:3**

"But I will sing of YOUR power;Yes, I will sing aloud of YOUR mercy *in the morning*," **Psalm 59:16** "But to YOU I have cried out, O LORD, and *in the morning* my prayer comes before YOU." **Psalm 88:13** "*It is* good to give thanks to THE LORD,And to sing praises to YOUR name, O MOST HIGH;" **Psalm 92:1**

"To declare YOUR lovingkindness *in the morning*,And YOUR faithfulness every night," **Psalm 92:2**

"Now *in the morning*, having risen a long while before daylight, HE went out and departed to a solitary place; and there HE prayed." Mark 1:35

SERMON POINT #2: WORSHIP GOD...

...AT NIGHT

"I will bless THE LORD who has given me counsel;My heart also instructs me *in the night* seasons." **Psalm 16:7** "Now it came to pass in those days that HE went out to the mountain to pray, and continued *all night* in prayer to GOD." Luke 6:12 "But a *t midnight* Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to GOD, and the prisoners were listening to them." Acts 16:25

SERMON POINT #3: WORSHIP GOD...

...ALL THE TIME

"I have become as a wonder to many,... Let my mouth be filled *with* YOUR praise*And with* YOUR glory *all the day*." **Psalm 71:7-8**

"Plead *my cause,* O LORD...Fight against those who fight against me...And my tongue shall speak...of YOUR praise *all the day* long." **Psalm 35:1, 28**

"THE LORD will command HIS lovingkindness *in the daytime,And in the night* HIS song *shall be* with me-..." **Psalm 42:8** "I will sing to THE LORD **as long as I live**;I will sing praise to my GOD while **I have my being**." **Psalm 104:33** "Therefore by HIM let us *continually offer the sacrifice of praise* to GOD, that is, the fruit of *our* lips, giving thanks to HIS name." **Hebrews 13:15** "*Rejoice always*, pray without ceasing, in *everything give thanks*, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." I Thessalonians 5:16-18

DAVID'S SONG OF THANKS-GIVING

So they brought the ark of GOD...in the midst of the tabernacle that David had erected for it. Then they offered...offerings before GOD." I Chronicles 16:1
