*"And a servant of  
the Lord **must:**  
not **quarrel** but be  
**gentle** to all, able to  
**teach, patient,***

**II TIM. 2:25**  
*...in **humility** correcting  
those who are in  
**opposition**, if GOD  
perhaps will grant them  
**repentance**, so that they  
may know the **truth**,*

**II TIM. 2:26**  
*and that they may **come**  
to **their senses** and  
**escape the snare of the**  
**devil**, having been taken  
captive by him to do his  
**will.***
