He or she should be familiar with the culture and dynamics of the community, committed to the goals of the *CDF Freedom Schools* program and Shiloh CDC's mission.

Site Coordinator works under the supervision of the Project Director. The site coordinator should be experienced in working with large groups of children and in partnerships with young adults. He or she must be responsible, energetic, able to think on his or her feet, well organized, and a strong role model. He or she may have worked in the past as a *CDF Freedom Schools* servant leader intern or in a similar position. The site coordinator should have strong leadership skills with empathy for children and their parents. He or she should be familiar with the culture and dynamics of the community, committed to the goals of the *CDF Freedom Schools* program and Shiloh CDC's mission.

Servant Leader Intern are responsible for the front-line care and nurturing of the children. Using the Integrated Reading Curriculum, they serve as facilitators in the classroom and as leaders of parent workshops and community outreach activities.
