

INTRODUCTION TO DOXOLOGIES IN THE BIBLE

GREEK WORD FOR "GLORY:" *Doxa - Δόξα* "Brilliant Light" A **doxology** (Ancient Greek: $\delta o \{ o \lambda o \gamma (a \ doxologia, from \delta \delta \{ a, \ doxa, "glory" and -\lambda o \gamma (a, -logia, "saying")^{[1][2][3]} is a short <u>hymn</u> of$ praises to <u>God</u> in various formsof <u>Christian</u> worship, often addedto the end of <u>canticles</u>, <u>psalms</u>, and hymns. The tradition derivesfrom a similar practice in the<u>Jewish synagogue</u>,^[4] wheresome version of the <u>Kaddish</u>serves to terminate each sectionof the service.
